### HANGING GUIDE

### **Before You Start**

- 1. **Delivery Check-Up**: Look over your wallpaper package to verify it's all in tip-top condition.
- 2. **Light It Up**: Good lighting is your best friend. It helps you see what you're doing and spot any issues early.
- 3. **Warm and Breezy**: Keep the room cozy (at least 12°C or 55°F) with good ventilation.
- 4. **Label Love**: Hold onto all the labels until the job is done. They're like your wallpaper's ID cards.

### **Surface Prep**

- 1. **Brush Off**: Use a stiff brush to clear away dirt and loose material.
- 2. **Spotless**: Clean off any marks with a detergent solution and let it dry.
- 3. **Mold Patrol**: If there's mold or algae, treat it with a fungicidal wash. Let it dry completely.
- 4. **Patchwork**: Fill any holes or cracks with filler, smooth it out, and let it dry. Patience is key!

## **Applying the Wallpaper**

- 1. Glue It Up: Roll on undiluted adhesive to the wall with a medium-pile roller, one drop area at a time.
- 2. **Hang Time**: Pop the dry wallpaper onto the adhesive-coated wall. Smooth it out with a soft spatula in an up-and-down motion.
- 3. **Trim Time**: Give it 15 minutes to settle, then trim the top and bottom.

### **Hanging Method**

### **Overlap and Trim**

- 1. **Overlap Magic**: Overlap the wallpaper to match the design.
- 2. **Trim Trick**: Use a sharp knife and a straightedge to trim the overlap down the middle. Edges should be neat and aligned.

### **Butt Joint (Side by Side)**

- 1. **Edge Match**: Place the wallpaper edges next to each other with no overlap.
- 2. **Match Design**: Ensure the design aligns perfectly at the seam.
- 3. **Smooth Operator**: Use a seam roller to gently press the joint flat and secure.
